

Master Sheet For Boards of Review

1. Scout must schedule a Board of review a minimum of one week in advance.
 2. Scout must be in a CLASS A UNIFORM for a Board of Review
 3. In addition to the questions below, a Scout must be knowledgeable in the requirement areas of whatever rank he is striving to attain.

1. When you give the Scout salute, what does it signify?
(respect to the Flag, courtesy to others)
2. Recite the Scout Graces: Any 1 for Tenderfoot and Second Class, All 3 for First Class through Eagle (see Troop 72 handouts)
3. Who is the founder of Scouting and what was his native country?
(Robert Baden-Powell, England)
4. Who brought the Scouting movement to the United States?
(William D. Boyce)
5. What is the only badge earned in Cub Scouts that can be worn on the Boy Scout Uniform?
(Arrow of Light)

Flag Questions:

1. Name the first official American Flag. (Old Glory)
2. What is the date of Flag Day? (June 14)
3. How many stars are on the current United States flag? (50)
4. How many stripes are on the current United States flag and what do they represent?
(13, the original 13 colonies)
5. Why should the American Flag be flown upside down? (As a distress signal)
6. What do the colors on the United States Flag represent?
(Red - Hardiness & Valor, White - Purity & Innocence
Blue - Vigilance, Perseverance & Justice)

Pennsylvania History Questions:

1. Who is the founder of Pennsylvania? (William Penn)
2. What is the capital of Pennsylvania? (Harrisburg)
3. What number star on the American Flag represents Pennsylvania? (2nd)
4. Which President of the United States came from Pennsylvania? (James Buchanan)

5. What is the state tree? (Eastern Hemlock)
6. What is the state flower? (Mountain Laurel)
7. What is the state animal? (White-Tail Deer)
8. What is the state fish? (Brook Trout)
9. What is the state bird? (Ruffed Grouse)
